5. Caesar had a prophetic dream and narrowly escaped death.

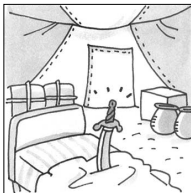

C *Match the statement with the correct picture.*

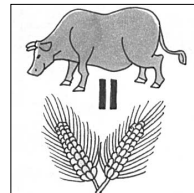
1. I dreamed I was being chased by someone with a gun. I heard the horrible blasts from the gun.
